

South Pole - Explore Internship Programme

Overview

South Pole launched the Explore Internship Programme to attract, develop, and engage undergraduate talent with a passion for sustainability. Designed to give students meaningful exposure to climate action and professional skill-building, Explore provides an entry point for the next generation of changemakers while building South Pole's future talent pipeline.

Challenge

As a global leader in climate action, South Pole recognised the need to invest early in future talent. The company wanted to create an internship programme that not only gave students valuable work experience but also introduced them to the climate industry in a structured, scalable way. The aim was to inspire students from diverse backgrounds to pursue careers in sustainability while supporting business productivity through short-term assignments.

Solution - The Explore Programme

The Explore Internship Programme was created to provide undergraduates with a six-month, project-based placement within South Pole. The programme:

- Engages students across Europe (with global expansion planned).
- Aligns internship work with South Pole's climate projects, covering 10 UN Sustainability Goals.
- Provides interns with mentorship, professional development opportunities, and a flexible work environment.
- Encourages cross-functional learning, with projects spanning six continents and over 700 climate action initiatives.
- Interns are recruited through a structured process led by Early Career Specialists, HRBPs, and line managers, ensuring placements are aligned to business needs while offering meaningful learning experiences.

Impact

- Talent pipeline: Interns gain skills and networks that prepare them for careers in sustainability, with the potential to transition into full-time roles.
- Productivity boost: Business lines benefit from additional resource and fresh perspectives from motivated undergraduates.
- Diversity and inclusion: The programme is designed to attract students from a wide range of backgrounds, creating equitable access to sustainability careers.
- Employer brand: South Pole positions itself as a destination for purpose-driven early careers talent.

The Explore Internship Programme showcases how South Pole is investing in the workforce of tomorrow. By combining structured learning, hands-on project work, and global collaboration, Explore is shaping the next generation of professionals committed to driving climate impact.

What Is Explore?

- Explore is the new name for South Pole's existing Internship Programme designed to recruit and develop talent during
 the undergraduate university years.
- In Q2 of 2023, the programme will launch its first phase exclusively across Europe. We will then expand internships globally for a new cohort intake for September.
- The ideal candidate should be interested and passionate in their chosen field, fluent in English and hold strong work related behaviours.
- An intern is hired for 6 months.

Why?

As a leading company in the field, South Pole wants to attract the next generation that will combat climate change.

As a new generation is entering the workforce, they may join South Pole with a fresh and different outlook to how climate change can be actioned on, all the while South Pole provides the interns with valuable work experience. This allows us to recognise and engage with future talent early as these interns may become our trainees or junior employees once they complete their degree.

Application Process

- Business Line leaders with their respective HRBPs will identify opportunities based on need and headcount and notify relevant Line Managers of their inclusion into the process.
- Intern Managers with selected intern positions will propose the position in the headcount plan file via their HRBP
- The Early Career Specialist (ECS) acts as recruiter admins the applications in Team Tailor, screens applicants, visits universities, forwards relevant applicants to Intern Managers for selection of interviews;
- Only one interview is carried out by the Intern Manager;
- Intern Manager selects and indicates successful applicant(s) to ECS who will send out the offer;
- Once the offer is accepted, ECS reaches out to People Services to have the contract sent out;
- ECS will begin the onboarding process for the interns.

"In September 2021, I joined South Pole for a six-month internship on the Funding and Partnerships Team within Climate Investments. My team was quite small so I was able to make connections with my Senior Leadership Team relatively quickly.
